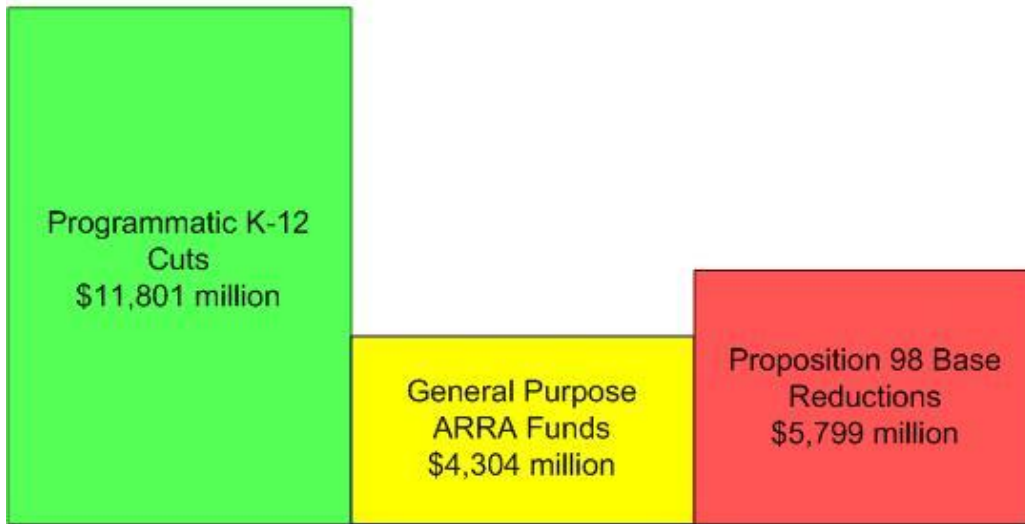


ARRA Funding Does NOT Backfill K-12 Cuts



Notes:

Programmatic cuts include all enacted and proposed categorical and revenue limit reductions for 2008-09 and 2009-10, including the loss of COLA.

General purpose ARRA funds include all K-12 stabilization funds and half of IDEA funds. Up to half of IDEA funds may be used to buy out "encroachment," thereby making them available for general purposes. Title I funds do not go to every district and are highly restricted, so they can not be used to backfill state funding cuts.

Proposition 98 base reductions include actions such as deferrals and "swapping out" one-time dollars for General Fund appropriations that have permanently reduced the minimum guarantee on an ongoing, annual basis. ***These are in addition to the programmatic cuts.***
