- » There are 6 common administration districts statewide (an elementary school district and a high school district governed by the same elected board)



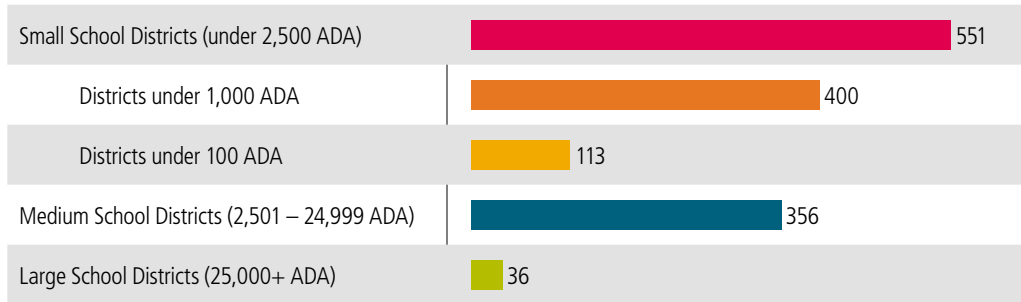

Sizes of K-12 School Districts (based on average daily attendance)

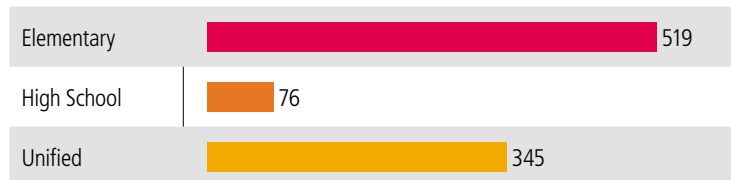


53% Of California school board members serve on the board of a small school district

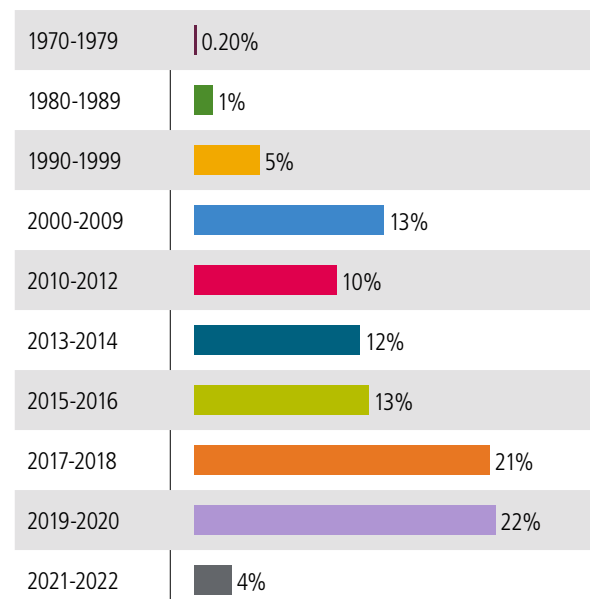
Types of K-12 School Districts

21% of current school and county board members were elected or appointed on or after November 3, 2020

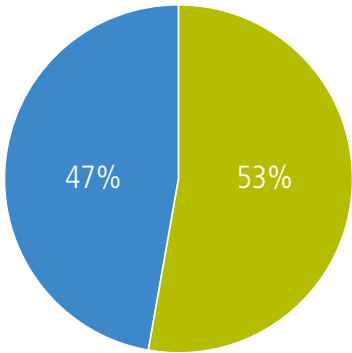

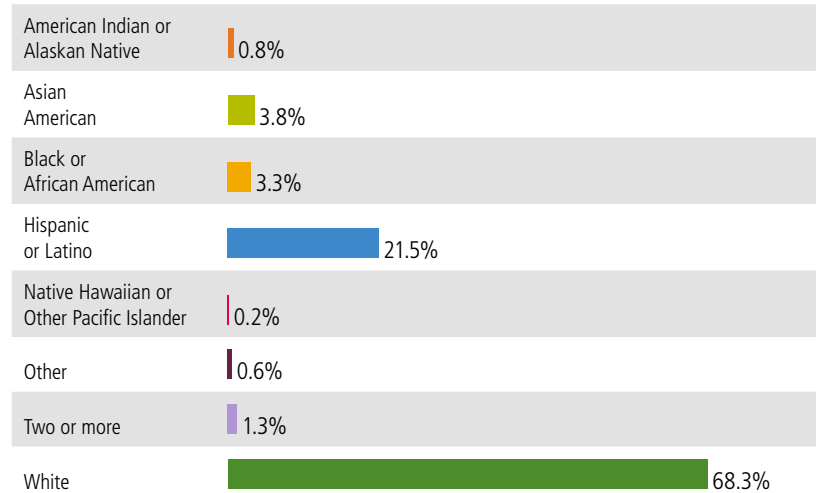
Governing Board Member Demographics
