## What you need to know

- Open enrollment into affordable coverage through Covered California is November 15, 2014 – February 15, 2015.
- Eligible children, families, and individuals can enroll in no- or low-cost Medi-Cal year round.
- Medi-Cal and Covered California coverage needs to be renewed every year. Enrollment counselors can help.
- Special enrollment through Covered California may be available anytime for those who have lost their health coverage outside of the open enrollment period.
