

Notices – Cancellation, Release of Liability and Shuttle/Transportation

Please review the following notice carefully if you will be attending the 2024 ACSA & CSBA Coast2Coast (C2C) Washington, D.C., Federal Advocacy Trip, April 8 – 10, 2024.

Attendees shall be required to follow procedures and protocols established at the conference venue and hotels to ensure the health and safety of all attendees. Attendees also shall be required to execute a release of liability form, by which the attendee shall agree to voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID- 19 or other contagious or infectious disease and to release ACSA and CSBA from any liability related to such exposure.

❖ By attending the 2024 ACSA & CSBA C2C, attendees' consent to the recording and capturing of their image and/or voice in any non-private space and authorize Organizers to use any such recordings for the Organizers' purpose.

Cancellation of Event by Organizers

Organizers, ACSA and CSBA, reserve the right to cancel the event at any time. If Organizers cancel this event, attendees' registration fees will be refunded. Organizers will not be liable for any personal or business costs associated with participation in C2C if the event is cancelled. Hotel reservation made in the C2C room block can only be cancelled by the registrant.

Cancellation of Registration by Registrant

Registration Fee: For a refund of the registration fee, cancellation must be submitted in writing no later than 11:59 p.m. (PST) on March 21, 2024. If cancellation is received by March 21, 2024, a 25% processing fee will be applied and the balance of the registration fee will be refunded. There will be no refund for any cancellation received after March 21, 2024. However, substitution of another individual in registrant's LEA is permitted if made by April 4, 2024. Requests for refunds made after March 21, 2024, will not be reviewed until after the event, and responses to requests may take an additional 8-10 weeks.
