REGISTRATION QUESTIONS

How do I register for the 2023 Coast2Coast Federal Advocacy Trip?

What is the registration timeline?

Regular: \$675 until February 28, 2023

Late: \$795 starting March 1, 2023

Registration closes on April 7, 2023.

How do I pay for my registration?

Payments may be made via credit card or check.

CSBA accepts the following credit cards: Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover.

Can I pay my C2C registration with a Purchase Order?

How do I update my district roster?

Please contact the CSBA Registrar at register@csba.org to update your roster.

I am an individual who would like to register and need my CSBA Member or Company ID to register. Who should I contact?

Please email the CSBA registrar at register@csba.org to obtain your CSBA member ID or CSBA company ID.

Who can attend the trip?

Please note that, due to space constraints, congressional offices limit the number of constituents who can attend an in-person meeting at any one time. So, in order to accommodate all the LEAs in a particular congressional district, we must cap at three the number of trustees or staffers from a single LEA that can attend the in-person meeting on Capitol Hill. LEAs are free to register as many approved participants for Coast2Coast as they'd like, but LEAs sending more than three people to the event will have to choose three members from their delegation to represent the school district or COE at the congressional meeting. Approved participants include School Board Members, Superintendents, Deputy Superintendents, Directors, and Cabinet-Level Positions only (no EAs).

Registrants who do not fulfill the position requirement will have their registrations cancelled, and be refunded less the \$50.00 cancellation fee.

I have already registered but I am no longer able to attend C2C; can I transfer my registration?

Yes. Attendees can transfer their registration to someone in their same District/County Office of Education by emailing register@csba.org. The deadline to transfer your registration is April 7, 2023.

What is the cancellation policy?

Should an attendee need to cancel, a \$50.00 cancellation fee will be deducted from the event registration fee until March 31, 2023. After March 31, 2023, a 50 percent cancellation fee shall be applied until April 14, 2023. No refunds will be given after April 14, 2023.
