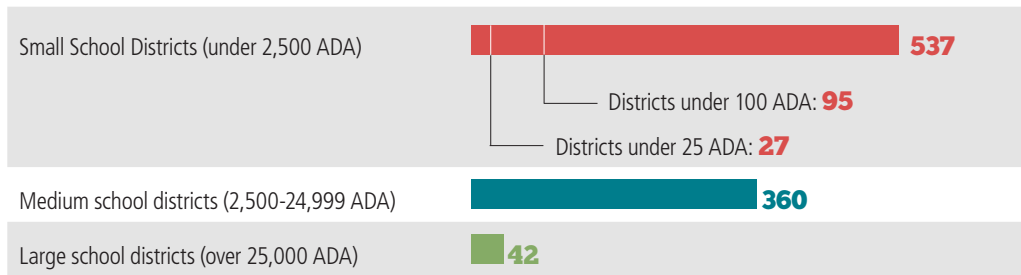

Sizes of K-12 School Districts



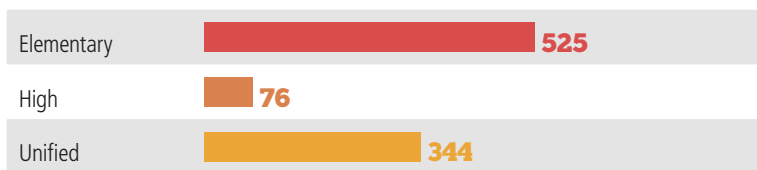
53 School district reorganizations/unifications since 1996

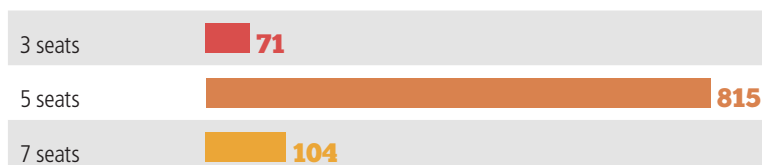

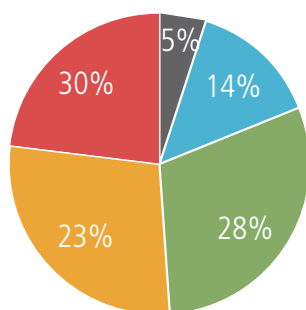

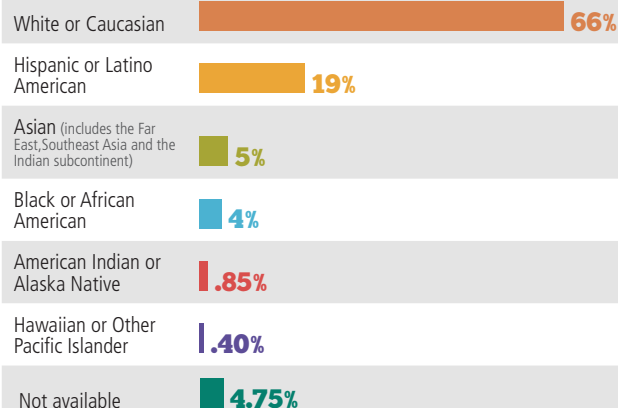
Governing Board Member Demographics³
